

New Business License Application/ Renewal Requirements For Industrial Facilities



SB205
Are you ready?



Senate Bill 205 was signed
into law by Governor Newsom on
October 2, 2019.

It took effect January 1st, 2020.

SB205 requires that a person
applying to a city or county for a new
or renewed business license
demonstrate enrollment in an
NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge
Elimination System) Permit, if such
permit is required.

Businesses with primary SIC codes
that are identified in or are applicable
to the General NPDES permit for
Storm Water Discharge Associated
with Industrial Activities, also known
as the Stormwater Industrial General
Permit or IGP, are required to
adhere to SB205.
